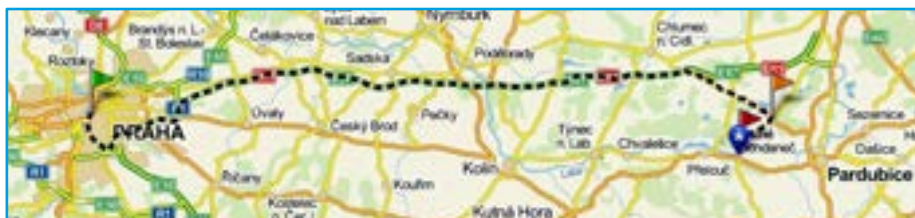

LOCATION

Mělčice lake is a man-made waterski venue situated on the outskirts of a small village. The Marin Club itself is located on a pine-tree peninsula.

GPS coordinates: 50°02'38.6"N.

- The site is roughly 15 km west of Pardubice and around 100 km east of Prague, the capital of the Czech Republic.



- **Driving from Prague:** Take the D11 Highway towards Hradec Kralové and use the exit 68 toward Lázně Bohdaneč. At the roundabout in Lázně Bohdaneč, follow the signs for Živanice-Mělčice.

Pardubice Airport

- **Driving from Pardubice Airport:** Follow the main route in the direction of Přelouč. In the village of Valy u Přelouče turn right, cross the narrow bridge to Mělčice, and follow the signs for the E&A Championship.

TOURNAMENT LAKE

- The courses are laid out on the eastern side of the lake, sheltered from the prevailing westerly winds.
- Trick practice can also take place in the eastern part of the complex.
- The starting dock for slalom and tricks is about an 8-minutes walk (3 minutes by car) from the Club. A boat will be available to transport competitors there.



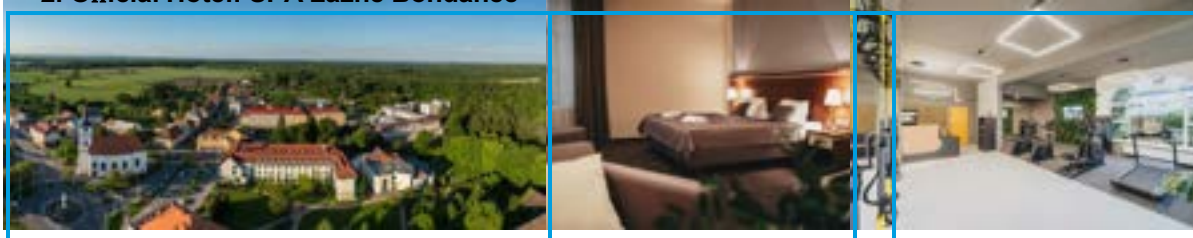

ENTRY AND ADMINISTRATION (New Rule 14:12)

Each Federation shall declare, through EMS, not later than 60 days before the scheduled start of the first event of the World Championships:

- The names of the members of its team
- The names of the competitors entered as “**Individuals**”
- The names of the competitors entered as Wild Cards
- The names of the Official reserves.

For each competitor registered, the events that they will compete in together with the ramp height for Jump need to be entered.

An entry is considered complete when the Skier’s name is registered in EMS and the full Entry Fee Payment has been received.

All payments need to be made by Credit Card/PayPal through EMS. For the Official Reserves, no payment is due at this time.

Any skier entered as a Wild Card or Individual is also to be considered to be a TEAM reserve.

An entered skier may be replaced by a different one without penalty, provided that they have already been entered as a Reserve skier, wild card or individual.

The 60 days deadline does not include those skiers who may additionally qualify **as individuals** through the Weekly or the Pro Ranking List (If applicable). For those skiers the following deadlines apply:

- 1) The deadline to enter skiers who qualify under the Weekly Ranking List is 30 days before the Championships.
- 2) **The deadline to enter skiers who qualify under the Pro Tour Ranking List is 15 days before the Championships.**

a) Fines for Late Registration.

Any Federation not meeting the registration deadlines will not be allowed to compete until their Federation pays a fine to the IWWF E&A Representative at the Championships. The fines are as follows:

- * **€ 25** per skier if the registration is made between 59 and 45 days before the scheduled start of the first event of the Championships
- * **€ 50** per skier if the registration is made between 44 to 30 days before the scheduled start of the first event of the Championships
- * **€ 75** per skier if the registration is made between 29 to 15 days before the scheduled start of the first event of the Championships
- * **Double the Entry Fee** per skier if the registration is made between 14 days until 12:00 (competition local time), 2 days before the scheduled start of the first event of the Championships

Example: scheduled start of the first event of the Championships is July 31 deadline to register skier is noon 12:00 UTC of July 29.

Two days before the start of the first event the entry lists shall be closed at noon 12:00 (competition local time) and thereafter the order of competitors entered and paid will be finalized and posted.

The Scorer in consultation with the Chief Judge should post Preliminary Running Orders 7 days

preceding the start of events with the orders clearly marked as “Preliminary and subject to change”. No change in this order is allowed after noon (competition local time) of the two days preceding the start of events except that a team representative may without penalty:

- 1) Withdraw a skier from the competition.
- 2) Replace an injured skier with a qualified official reserve from the same team with the authority of the Chief Judge and before the start of the first event, that is, before the first skier taking part in the first event has started.
- 3) The substitute skier shall start first in the series in which he is qualified unless the draw has not yet been completed.

b) Team or individual athletes not showing up:

In the event a team or individual athletes (for whom their Federation has submitted a competition entry), fail to show up for a competition their entry fee shall still be payable in full, unless a valid written excuse is received by 12 noon of two days before the start of the competition.

A valid excuse may include a sickness certificate or a certificated injury and should be considered and agreed as valid by the IWWF E&A Representative at the Championships. All fines have to be paid on-site to the IWWF E&A Representative at the Championships. No skiers will be allowed to start if any due fine is not paid.

If the “valid excuse” is accepted, the money will be refunded by the Organiser to the relative Federation, within 30 days after the end of the competition.

Official Entry and Entry fee

- **Entry Fee:**

- €280 per competitor (regardless of discipline).
- €40 per skier will go toward official's travel costs.
- €10 per skier will go to the WADA Fund.

Remitting parties are responsible for ALL fees or charges at both ends. Where bank charges or fees have been deducted, Federations/Skiers will be required to make good any shortfall at registration.

OFFICIAL SITE FAMILIARIZATION

(E&A Rule 14:07)

- The final **two days before** the Championships are reserved for Official Familiarization.
- Each competitor who has paid for Official Familiarization will be allocated a set number of passes or time, at the Chief Judge's discretion (ensuring equal opportunity for all):
 - Slalom: 4 passes or 6 minutes (whichever is less)
 - Tricks: 2 passes or 5 minutes (whichever is less)
 - Jump: 3 passes or 6 minutes (whichever is less)
- After the ITE closes (60 days before the event), the organizer (in consultation with the Chief Judge) will announce the official familiarization schedule at **45 days before** the start. If a Federation does not want to participate, they must notify the organizer and the Chief Judge as soon as possible. Familiarization times are scheduled by event group (slalom, tricks, jump by ramp height).
- Any athlete whose time has not been paid for **30 days before** the event or who is not ready to ski at their allotted time will lose their official familiarization slot.
- **Fees:** The maximum cost is €240 per hour, i.e., €4 per minute.

- The Chief Judge shall have the discretion to change the start time of team's familiarisation based on extraordinary circumstances.
- During the Official Familiarisation period the Chief Judge may allocate any available site familiarisation times but only to skiers who have not already used it or do not have time allocated.

I do hereby authorize any and all physicians, paramedics and other medical personnel and practitioners procured by, or on behalf of, the IWWF and the Organizer to administer first aid treatment, or any medical treatment, surgery or transportation in the event of any illness, accident or injury suffered and/or sustained by me at any time during my participation and competition in the Championships (or any part thereof) and hereby indemnify, and shall keep fully and effectively indemnified, the IWWF and the Organizer (including all directors, officers, employees, volunteers and other representatives thereof) upon demand from and against any and all claims, liabilities, demands, costs and expenses of whatsoever nature incurred and/or suffered by the same (or any of them) and arising from, and/or in connection with, the procurement and administration of such medical treatment and transportation in relation to any such illness accident or injury suffered and/or sustained by me;

4. I acknowledge the authority of IWWF [and its member National Federations and/or National Anti-Doping Organizations] under the IWWF Anti-Doping Rules to enforce, to manage results under, and to impose sanctions in accordance with the IWWF Anti- Doping Rules.
5. I acknowledge and agree that any dispute arising out of a decision made pursuant to the IWWF Anti-Doping Rules, after exhaustion of the process expressly provided for in the IWWF Anti-Doping Rules, may be appealed exclusively as provided in Article [13] of the IWWF Anti-Doping Rules to an appellate body for final and binding arbitration, which in the case of International-Level Athletes is the Court of Arbitration for Sport CAS).
6. I acknowledge and agree that the decisions of the arbitral appellate body referenced above shall be final and enforceable, and that I will not bring any claim, arbitration, lawsuit or litigation in any other court or tribunal.

Kunětice Mountain Castle

- A 30-minute drive from Mělice (and about 8,5 km from Hotel EURO Pardubice, 12 km from Lázně Bohdaneč). First mentioned during the Hussite wars, it later suffered damage in the Thirty Years'War.

UNESCO World Heritage Sites

- Kutná Hora: Only a 30-minutes drive away. Notable for the five-nave St. Barbara's Church (Gothic style) and the Cathedral of Our Lady in nerby Sedlec, plus the famous Ossuary. Kutná Hora's silver mines date back to 1260, and it has been on the UNESCO list since 1995.

Prague

- Known as the „City of a Hundred Spires”, Prague is a must-see. Enjoy its lively atmosphere, architectural heritage, and beautiful parks.
- From Pardubice, it’s about €10 by train (1 hour), directly into central Prague. Parking in the city center can be challenging.
- If driving, we recommend using the **Park&Ride** (“P+R”) facility at Černý Most (just off Highway D11). Parking there costs about €2 (CZK 50) for 24 hours. Then purchase a public transport ticket (about €5 for a 24-hour pass) and take the **Metro B** line from Černý Most to Můstek, emerging right at Wenceslas Square.
- Explore the Old Town Square, Betlémská Chapel, Charles Bridge, Malostranská Square, or take **Tram 22 to Prague Castle** (stop: Pražský hrad). Enjoy St. Vitus Cathedral, then head to Strahov Monastery for a panoramic view and a restaurant with great food at reasonable prices. Finally, stroll through Petřín Hill and Kinský Garden down to the Anděl metro station (Line B), which returns you to Černý Most.
