2. Conditions of the Competition:

The competition will be held at the Cableway in Szelment - Poland on Szelment Wielki lake, district Leszczewo, 15 km North from Suwalki in the following disciplines: Tricks, Slalom, Jump and overall. The competition will be carried out according to the rules of the IWWF World Cableski Technical Rules 2017.

A suggestion is to held the championships according to **Mode 2** :

In addition to this there will be no **Empty passes** throughout the competition. These rules are applied in order to make sure that the event runs swiftly and according to schedule.

3. Categories:

The competition will be carried out in the following Categories:
junior girls and boys U 19, junior girls and boys U15, senior men and women

4. Homologation:

This competition will be **Record Capability**, total length of the slalom and jump site of the cable is 300,5 m.

5. Drawing facility:

Rixen Cableway (4 pylons)

6. Applications:

The intention to enter is to be submitted by **July 08th**, entry form of the participants must sent no later than **August 25th, 2017** to the Organisers and Council Rep. The dates are only provisional. Correct ones will be announced at an official E&A Confederations website.

7. Judges

You can find the nominated judges at official cableski websites.

8. Entry fee:

The organiser collects an entry fee per skier: €120 for Juniors and €160 for Seniors. The entry fee must be paid in Euros in the competition office before training starts.

10. Prizes:

Medals for the first, second and third place in all events.

11. Liability:

The organiser according to the Letter of Agreement has bought a public liability insurance policy worth 1.000.000 Euro, and it's details will be published during the event at a place accessible for all participants. Nevertheless the competitors must supply their own insurance policies for accidents that may happen during the competition.

12. Special offer

The organiser provides the possibility of renting the cable for team trainings in Szlement. The price is 180 euros per 1 hour of training.

The office of The Polish Motorboat and Water Ski Association will make a day time schedule for each team on the basis of the e-mails applications and send the message to each team.

13. Catering
