AQUABIKE LICENSE

Athletes from foreign countries who have valid licenses issued by the national federation of their country, UIM issued and valid licenses can also participate in jet ski competitions in Aquabike Baltic Championship.

INSURANCE

All riders must have a valid Insurance Policy that covers:

- Civil Responsibility – min 25000 euro;
- Personal Insurance (that covers medical treatment, hospitalization and transportation home must be presented during registration);
- Indemnity Insurance – optional.

The paddock will be at New City Beach, Elk **GPS.; 53.8028788,22.3478131**

PIT PROCEDURES

Access to pit area will only be allowed to the persons and vehicles holding the official ABP paddock passes (seasonal or one event). Trailers / dollies must have Jet Ski's numbers and/or rider's name on the tongue for identification. Teams shall maintain flow patterns through the pit area, and shall not go against traffic. There shall be no smoking or open flames at the wet or dry pit area at any time. No alcohol is allowed in the pit area and drinking of alcohol is forbidden for team members during event hours.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

Baltic Championships – UIM technical requirements apply to the all classes.

Lithuanian Championships – UIM technical requirements apply to the all classes.

Poland Championship – UIM technical requirements apply to the all classes.

INSPECTION

Technical inspection shall be according to UIM rules. It is the Team's responsibility to report to the inspection area allowing adequate time for both pre- and post-race inspection and registration based on announced time schedule. Paddock crews will be responsible for assisting in weighing and in all inspection procedures. The organisation, its members, race sponsors and crane/forklift owners or operators accept no responsibility for injury, damage or any loss incurred while operating cranes or other equipment (whether weighing, lifting or other), at race site.

RACE NUMBERS

The size of the background of the numbers is at least 30 cm x 30 cm. The height of the numbers must be (at least) 22 cm and the distance between the numbers must be (at least) 13 mm, the numbers will be printed black (Arial Black) on white background for all categories. Race numbers not conform integrated in the Aquabike livery can be accepted as long as clearly readable by the timing officers and race officials.

START LINE

ROLLING START

Starting positions, in the first heat (moto 1) riders draw lots, choosing a starting position based on the number drawn. In the second and third heats (moto 2 and moto 3), they choose based on the place they took in the previous heat.

RUNABOUT all classes one start line is 18 drivers.

SKI all classes one start line is 18 drivers.

FINISH

The chequered flag signals the finish of the race.

PRICE GIVING CEREMONY

The prize giving ceremony will take place at the race site after the technical inspections of hulls and engines. First three places will receive Cups. On the podium, all riders must wear their wetsuit, racing gear, including the racing bib, and carry the racing helmet. The racing bib must be worn for all pre- and post-podium interviews.

GENERAL

Officials, staff, participants, their crews, families and sponsors will be subject to disciplinary action for their conduct in connection with all LVMSF events at all times. Penalties may be assessed to the owner and/or rider for unsportsmanlike conduct of their crew members, families and sponsors, as well as to the offenders themselves.

Unsportsmanlike conduct includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- Verbal abuse of participants, crew members, family members, sponsors, officials or staff
- Physical violence
- Threats
- Public obscene language
- Public statements or actions with a negative impact on the sport and or LVMSF
- Refusal to obey an order from a race official
- etc.

Penalties, as decided by the LVMSF Daily Management and/or LVMSF Committee, for unsportsmanlike conduct will be assessed by the LVMSF officials, the officer of the day or the LVMSF protest judge.

Any rider, crew member or official who is injured must report to the first aid centre for examination.

Riders participate in the race at their own responsibility and must have the necessary accident and life insurance.

Registration may be refused to any rider with outstanding financial issues with the LVMSF, or the Local Organising Committee.

PROTEST

Protests can be logged at the race secretariat within 1 hour from the time of posting of the results.

The protest fee is 150€.

PENALTY FEES

All penalty fees assessed during the event must be paid prior to participation in any subsequent Session.

Penalty fees cannot be subject to protests or appeals.

DURING EVENT ACTIVITIES

The participation of riders and team manager is compulsory to all the activities (Registration, Briefing, Prize giving podium) scheduled on the Official event timetable, unless differently specified by lvmsf.

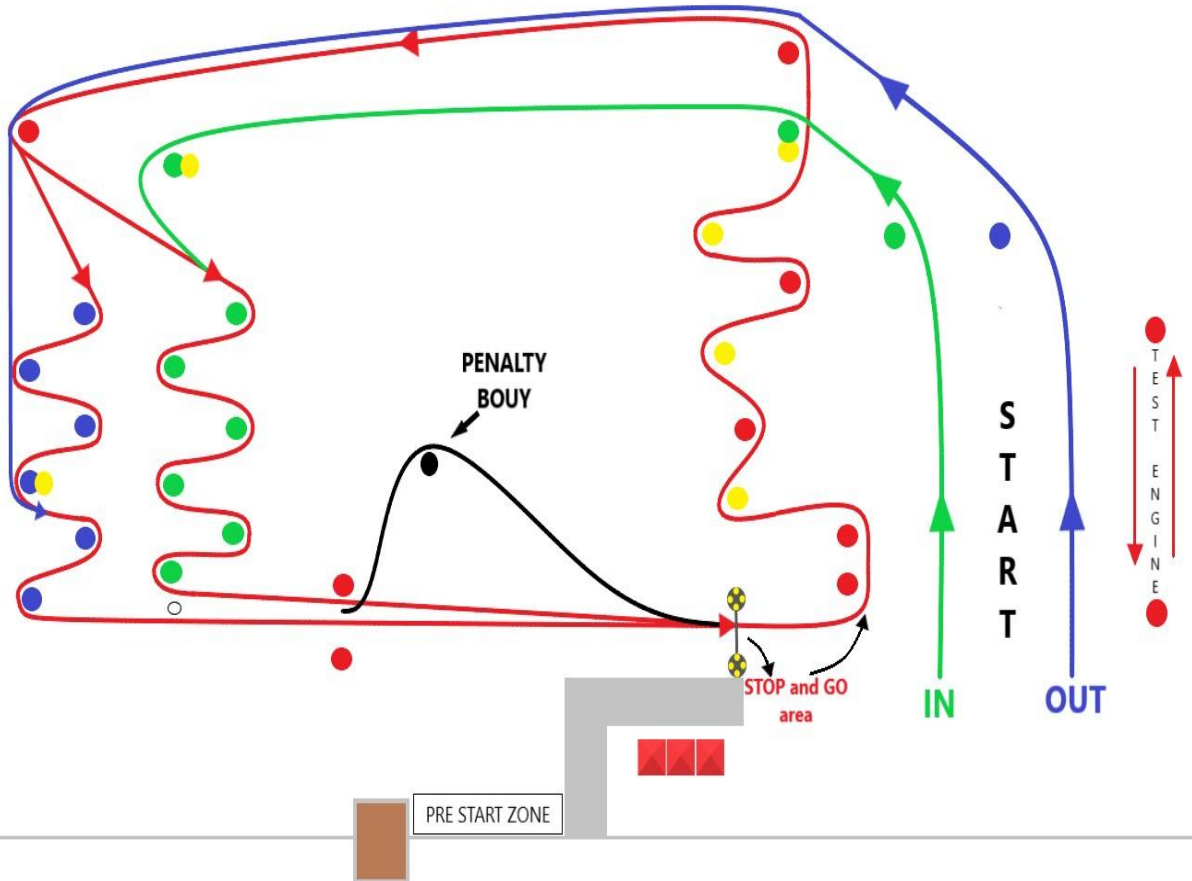
